- 2. Post-workshop reflective paper**

Participants will be expected to engage in the strategies facilitated in their selected track and reflect upon their learning and own leadership practices.

- 2-3 page paper, typed and double-spaced, with one-inch margins on all sides
- Title page that includes the following:
 - / Your name
 - / Instructor's name
 - / Track number and title
- Questions for reflection include:
 - / What were the key learnings from the track?
 - / In what ways will the ideas presented change your finance and leadership practices?
 - / What application will you make of the ideas presented?

- 3. Instructor-assigned readings related to current issues in Iowa School Finance**

Students will submit 1-2 page reflections for each of the assigned articles.
