Please note that Bachelor of Liberal Studies distance students are limited to registering for 4 units of on-campus coursework. If you wish to register for more than 4 units of on-campus coursework, you will be charged UNI mandatory fees based on the number of credits. Admission Requirements

To be admitted to the program, students must have:

- / 24 credits completed from an accredited institution (recommended)
- / Cumulative 2.0 GPA or above

Distribution Area Requirements

This unique, individualized program allows you to graduate with a customized liberal arts degree. You'll select three of the following distribution areas to concentrate your coursework: Communications & Arts, Humanities, Natural Sciences & Mathematics, Professional Fields and Social Sciences.

To satisfy a distribution area, you must complete 12 units of credit with at least 6 units designated as upper-level. A dedicated advisor is available to assist with course selection and academic planning.

Course Delivery Options

Guided Independent Study (GIS)

GIS delivers an effective, flexible alternative to traditional, semester-based courses. Enroll at any time, work at your own pace and take up to nine months to complete a web-based course.

Please note: GIS courses do not qualify students for financial aid at UNI. However, students enrolled at least half-time in semester-based coursework are eligible for federal financial aid. The aid received may apply toward their total bill, which may include charges for GIS courses.

Online semester-based courses

The University of Northern Iowa offers many semester-based courses at a distance. Complete your coursework without coming to campus.

On-campus courses

If you are within commuting distance of UNI, you may wish to consider on-campus or hybrid courses to complete your degree. Contact your advisor for a current schedule.

Transfer courses

As long as you complete a minimum of 30 semester hours from UNI during your junior and/or senior years, you may be able to enroll in courses at a community college or another four-year institution.
